Student membership

Motion:

The AGM approve the adoption of an additional membership to be named "Student" the membership will be for \$10, there will be no voting rights associated with this membership, must be a full-time student, show a student card as evidence and can only be a student member for a 12-month period, they must renew under one of the other membership options to remain a member after the initial 2 month period has expired.

Annual Increase to membership fees

Motion:

That the AGM confirm in accordance with Rule 24 (e) of the constitution that the annual membership and monthly membership fees for full, supporting and concession membership be increased by the annual Australian Consumer Price Index to the nearest whole dollar, There will be membership subscription fee increases on June 30 2025 that reflects CPI currently at 2.8% rounded to the nearest full number as per below:

The fees will be:

Full annual member - \$175 (previously \$170)

Full monthly member - \$18 (\$17)

Concession annual member - \$52 (\$50)

Supporting annual member - \$175 (\$170)

Student member - \$10 for one year
