## Introduction of Student membership for \$10

Voting rights are the concern, it could be seen as inequitable for concession members. There is already a waiting period for voting rights for monthly members, students should have to wait 12 months before voting rights.

Proposal - introduce a \$10 student membership limited to a trial to be determined by the National Committee/ membership committee with no voting rights.

After a lot of debate the AGM agreed to a trial period - the details to be deferred to the membership committee, Introductory membership for students \$10 for a 12 month period only, no voting rights. we will review this

The AMG voted that an introductory 12 months student membership \$10 for a limited period of 12 months to be referred to the Membership and National committee in accordance with the rules of ELA to conduct a trial period.
